





EXECUTIVE BUDGET SUMMARY

- Governor's May Budget Revise released May 12th
- No change from January's proposed budget \$227.3M ongoing
- State deficit projected to be \$32B
 - Increase of \$10B from January
- Continued support of the multi-year compact
 - Second year of agreement
 - 5% General Fund base increase
- Increases in exchange for CSU commitments to:
 - Expand student access, equity, and affordability
 - Create pathways to high-demand career opportunities
- State will monitor CSU's actions towards meeting the goals of the compact:
 - Reducing costs of attendance
 - Increasing enrollment
 - Increasing number of students prepared to enter high-need areas

May Revise Summary -\$227.3M in base growth









GENERAL FUND

No change from January **Budget. Continued support** of the multi-year compact with the CSU. 5-percent base increase of \$227.3M

UNIVERSITY FARMS

Restoration of \$75M in one-time General Fund support for improvements at CSU's farming operations. Cal Poly received \$18.75M.

FINANCING

Shift in financing of approximately \$856M for Cal Poly **Humboldt infrastructure projects** and CSU affordable student housing grants to CSU issued bonds and reflect increase of \$61M in ongoing debt service for those bonds.

CONSTRUCTION

Increase of \$3.1M in ongoing **General Fund support for the** construction of the Human **Identification Laboratory at** the CSU Chico campus through the issuance of CSU bonds.
