The Student Success Fee Allocation Advisory Committee (SSFAAC) met in February to discuss the allocation of one-time, non-recurring student success fee funds. The balance of approximately \$580,000 in available funds is due to actual revenues exceeding projections for the previous fiscal year.

With the support of campus leadership, the committee requested staff representatives from Academic Affairs, Student Affairs, and Facilities Management & Development meet with the committee and provide an overview of proposed projects that would have the most impact on the majority of students (see attached).
