BEACoN Research & Mentoring Program	<p>BEACoN provides the opportunity for students to be mentored and work with a faculty member on a research project.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Matched 50 students from a variety of disciplines with 42 faculty mentors from across campus.</li> <li>• Paid 38 faculty stipends (\$2,000 total for Winter/Spring)</li> <li>• Paid students a competitive stipend equivalent to \$18/hour for 10 hours/week for Winter and Spring Quarters, to allow them to pursue this opportunity.</li> <li>• Research projects lead to conference presentations and published works, which creates academic opportunities for pursuing masters or doctoral degrees.</li> <li>• Provided workshops and trainings for student participants.</li> <li>• Added a BEACoN Travel Fund and sponsored students to attend conferences to present their research.</li> <li>• Hosted a culminating Research Symposium during Finals Week where all students presented research posters of their work.</li> </ul>	50
